Eco Energy World secures the go ahead for 410 MW of solar projects in Queensland, Australia

Eco Energy World (EEW), an Australian developer of large-scale solar projects, is excited to announce the approval of 3 new solar projects totaling 410 MW. Including EEW's largest solar project to-date of 280 MW in Bouldercombe, Queensland.

All the utility scale projects will be connected directly to the Queensland grid, supplying electricity to the state. But this doesn't limit them to supplying Queensland only, with there being the potential that they will supply clean energy to New South Wales, Victoria and South Australia. Aiding not only Queensland but Australia to reach its sustainable, clean and reliable energy future.

EEW Chairman Svante Kumlin stated: "Queensland has huge potential for solar energy with its high irradiance, good infrastructure and availability of land. These projects will contribute to Queensland's target to reach 50% renewable energy generation. We are so pleased for the Bouldercombe, Yarranlea and Broadlea areas. These projects will increase the utility solar generation by approximately 410 MW and will create new opportunities for the community including adding hundreds of jobs and services."

EEW has previously secured grid and planning for 160 MW



of solar projects in Australia. This brings the total ready to build portfolio of projects to 570 MW, with a total construction value of \$AU 900million. All these projects are planned to start construction in Q3 2017, and to be connected to the grid from late Q4 2017 to Q2 2018.

EEW is one of Australia's largest developers of utility scale solar power projects and is targeting to develop a minimum 1GW of solar projects in Australia by 2019.
